Application:

The applicant must

- submit a St Paul's College Academic Scholarship application form.
- register online for the academic test with ACER and pay the registration fee. (details to be published)
- sit the academic test on the given date. (date to be published)
- submit a cover letter and a detailed curriculum vitae addressing the criteria.
- be prepared to attend an academic scholarship interview.

The success of applicants will be based on their written application, the interview, and their performance in the academic test.

Tenure:

Available to *new* and *current* St Paul's College students entering Year 7, 9, 10 or 11, in the year following application. Tenable for the remaining years at St Paul's College (if scholarship criteria is maintained)

Value:

25%-60% remission of Tuition Fees for remaining years at St Paul's College.

Criteria

- Excellent performance on the ACER Academic test
- Demonstrated academic commitment (i.e. school reports and NAPLAN results)
- Demonstrated history of achievement at school or in the community (i.e. awards or certificates received)
- Personal qualities (i.e. school reports or references)

- Ability to contribute to the co-curricular program at St Paul's College.
